





Message from the President

Amid the world full of unpredictable challenges in 2022, the purpose of "Uplift and Power the world to a new height" is the compass guiding BAFS Group to be unwavering in our commitments toward a strong and sustainable business and continues to uplift the society and the world, in terms of all aspects of the economy, environment, and social, through a strict adherence in the good governance principles.

In the past year, aviation and tourism sectors are still affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and taking time to fully recover; however, BAFS Group has maintained international standards and the highest safety of aviation refueling services to ensure the nation's energy and air transportation security. In 2022, BAFS has received ISO 22301:2019 certification, illustrating that we have systematically committed to business continuity. We also focus on risk management, business expansion, and diversification, which recently advanced to three business groups comprising (1) Aviation, (2) Utilities and Power; and (3) Business Solutions and Services. Furthermore, we have been developing numerous digital solutions to increase efficiency and provide our members with a better quality of life, enabling BAFS Group to tackle any situation.

Recognizing that Climate Change will profoundly affect all of our stakeholders, BAFS Group announced our intentions to be one of the Climate Action Leading Organizations in September 2022. We aim to reduce 20% of emissions against a 2019 baseline by 2030 and set the goal of reaching Net-Zero emissions by the year 2050. We have also been working closely with our partners and relevant parties to promote the use of sustainable aviation fuel to reduce emissions from the aviation industry, which is one of the contributors to global GHG emissions.

Over the past four decades, BAFS Group has been working hard to improve the lives of the people in our communities, especially those who live in close vicinity of our operating sites. In 2022, we took significant steps toward the communities, such as the firefighting training to raise safety awareness in communities near Don Mueang Storage Station, the Community Health Check Project surrounding Suvarnabhumi Storage Station, the organic rice farming near the fuel Depot in Phichit province, and the Eco-Forest project at ATCE power plant in Prachinburi province, and the circular farming which uses fertilizer from organic compost, called "Farm Hug by BAFS Group"; moreover, we have supported scholarships to students in the seven provinces we currently operate in.

With our sustainability performance comprising of economy, environment, social, and governance, our corporate governance level of listed companies for 2022 was "Excellent," assessed by the Thai Institute of Directors Association (IOD). We were certified as a member of the Private Sector Collective Action Coalition against Corruption of Thailand (CAC) since 2014. Furthermore, BAFS has also been recognized in the prestigious list of sustainable stocks (THSI: Thailand Sustainability Investment) for the 8th consecutive year.

In 2023, there are signs of recovery for the aviation and tourism sectors after the COVID-19 pandemic, but uncertainties and challenges from geopolitics, energy crisis, and risk of recession still remain. To rise above the challenges and achieve our sustainability goals, we will need greater and deeper collaboration from all sectors. BAFS Group believes that we will be able to thrive through challenges in the future with our dedication, propensity for growth, and the support from our stakeholders. Together we will co-create values and uplift the world through sustainable business.

BAFS Group Looking Forward by President

Q: BAFS Group's performance in 2022

A: There were positive signs of the gradual recovery of the tourism and aviation industries. BAFS Group uplifted a total aviation fuel volume of 2,990 million liters at Suvarnabhumi Airport and Don Mueang International Airport, an increase of 83% compared to the previous year. Furthermore, as we invested in solar power plants, we were able to record additional revenue from electricity sales of 331.6 million baht, an increase of 22.7% from 2021. In 2022, BAFS Group's total income was 2,334.3 million baht, an increase of 40.3% from 2021, and EBITDA of 974.3 million Baht, 162.3% from 2021.

Q: The highlights in 2022

A: 2022 was a year of challenges; hence, BAFS Group has continued to build a robust and sustainable business foundation, enabling our organization to tackle any situation and challenges in the future. Primarily, our new subsidiary was founded to invest in domestic and international renewable energy projects, and we have advanced into the adjacent business, the aviation refueling vehicle, and related equipment. In the past year, we have been co-creating our culture and critical behaviors to adapt to the changing world. Moreover, we have continued to develop the digital solutions to increase efficiency in our operations.

Q: The announcement of ESG to strengthen BAFS Group

Thriving businesses concerned with ESG Framework - Environment, Social, and Governance, is the pathway to ensure sustainability and strength of BAFS Group. For the environment, in 2022, we announced our intentions to be one of the Climate Action Leading Organizations, setting the goal of achieving Net-Zero emissions by 2050. For the social aspect, we have continued to create positive value for the communities, especially those in the vicinity of our operating sites, such as the circular farming, called "Farm Hug by BAFS Group" in Don Mueang Storage Station, and the organic rice farming near the fuel Depot in Phichit province. In addition to our effort for the environment and society, we recognize the vital mission of conducting business efficiently with good governance and continuously review and update our governance policy. As a result, our corporate governance level of listed companies for 2022 was awarded the highest rating of "Excellent" for the 14th consecutive year.

Q: Road to Net Zero

A: BAFS Group is committed to playing our part in reducing the impact of Climate Change. We aim to reduce 20% of emissions against a 2019 baseline by 2030 and set the goal of reaching Net-Zero emissions by the year 2050 with the strategy of "ZERO" to achieve them: (1) Z stands for Zero Emission. (2) As part of the Energy Transition (E) strategy, we increase the use of Electric vehicles and EV chargers in our operating sites. (3) In Response to nature and low carbon society (R), we launched the projects such as Road to Zero Waste and Eco-Forest. and (4) we explore the opportunity for green investment (O); for instance, we have been partnering and worked closely with related parties to promote the use of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) to reduce emissions from the Aviation sector.

Q: The challenges towards reaching Net Zero goal by 2050

A: Recognizing the importance of reducing emissions across our entire supply chain, we have embarked in the journey to achieve the target of reaching Net-Zero emissions by the year 2050. However, the significant challenges remain in the areas of climate solutions and technology needed for decarbonization such as carbon capture and storage, while at the same time, finding the right balance in terms of investment cost and the needs of all stakeholders.

Q: The key goals to achieve in 2023

A: In 2023, we pledge to grow our businesses in alignment with BAFS Group's strategies (2022-2026): (1) we aim to advance investment continually, mainly in domestic and international renewable energy, to reach the Net Zero target by 2050, (2) we aim to accelerate efficiency through digital transformation, organization transformation, and agility, and (3) most importantly, we will drive continuous people development and well being.

Q: Road to BAFS Group's Sustainability goals

A: BAFS Group remains committed in our pledge toward a strong and sustainable business, embracing and balancing ESG to continue following our founding purpose of "Uplift and Power the world to a new height"

Organization Transformation Strateg





Sustainability Materiality





Commitment to Net Zero

Road to Net Zero

This global warming has exacerbated in all regions of the world and has produced a wide-range impact on societies and the environment. Therefore, all sectors must cooperate in reducing greenhouse gases to not exceeding 1.5 degrees Celsius and maintaining the global temperature. Since 2019, BAFS has reduced the environmental impact of its business operations. The company has offset all greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) from its operations to zero and has been continuously certified as a Carbon Neutral Company. Alongside setting a goal to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to zero by 2050.

ZERO Strategy

To achieve corporate-level carbon neutrality and net zero greenhouse gas emissions, the Company has implemented the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions through the "ZERO" strategy as follows:



Z (Zero Emission)

Target to reduce greenhouse gas emissions for 20% by 2030

Reduce net greenhouse gas emissions to **Zero** by 2050



Climate Action Leading Organization

BAFS is one of the 48 organizations to lead the way in reducing greenhouse gas emissions and declaring its commitment to achieve Net Zero by 2050 under Thailand Carbon Neutral Network by Thailand Greenhouse Gas Management Organization (Public Organization) on 23 September 2022





Solar Roof Top Project

BAFS has installed Solar Cell Roof Top at the Don Mueang Storage field with a total production capacity of 660 kWp. It was expected to reduce electricity consumption by 35% per year compared to the base year 2019.

E (Energy Transition)

To diminish corporate greenhouse gas emissions and achieve the Net Zero target, BAFS has installed rooftop solar cells in the office building. The goal is to increase the proportion of electricity consumption from clean energy by supporting electric vehicle usage within the organization. Therefore, Electric vehicle charging points have been installed in the company's area.





BEV Hydrant dispenser Project

BAFS started experimenting with the BEV Hydrant dispenser service for two vehicles at Don Mueang Airport. It was the first service in Thailand and Southeast Asia. The Company aims to replace diesel-to-BEV refueling vehicles in the future.



Electric vehicle charging points

BAFS encourages employees to initiate the use of electric cars within the company's premises. Electric vehicle charging points have been installed in the office building area to be an environment-friendly company and to reduce greenhouse gas emissions within the organization.



Road to Zero Waste Project

BAFS has joined the Vibhavadi Zero Waste project and received cooperation from employees in bringing recyclable waste into the upcycling process again. In 2022, BAFS created a campaign for employees to continue efficiently waste sorting and specified a clear waste management destination to reduce the amount of waste going to landfills and the environmental impact.



R (Nature and Low Carbon Society)

BAFS Group strives to maintain and minimize environmental and community impacts for longterm sustainability. Therefore, it has implemented projects related to sustainable operations including the efficient use of resources, such as the Road to Zero Waste project and the BAFS Eco Forest project.





BAFS Eco Forest Project

BAFS Eco Forest Project aims to replenish green space and provide carbon storage for the community. Moreover, this project is a Carbon Neutral Event that offsets the total carbon content of 8.59 tons of carbon dioxide equivalent.



O (Opportunity for Green Investment)

BAFS concerns with the impact on the environment. The company increased the proportion of investment in clean energy and reduced the country's greenhouse gas emissions. In 2021, the company has signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Bio Jet Fuel with Mitr Phol Biofuel and Bangchak Corporation Public Company Limited to study biofuels that are environmentally friendly and Comply with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and International Aviation Association (IATA) standards to enhance the capability of providing sustainable aviation fuel and reducing greenhouse gas emissions of the country and the aviation industry.





Energy Management and Energy Efficiency



The Target of Electric Energy Management

In 2022, BAFS contributed electricity production of **4,371,718** kilowatt-hours. By the year 2030, the amount of electricity consumption will decrease by **40%** compare to the base year of 2019. This year the company has reduced energy consumption by **27.43%** compared to the Base year of 2019



The Target of Water Management

BAFS has set the target to reduce water consumption by 10% compared to the Base year of 2019. In 2022, total water consumption was 16,367 cubic meters and decreased by 24.48% compared to the base year with a base value for the past 4 years at 2,165 cubic meters per month.



The Target of Waste Management

In 2022, BAFS has 3,580 kilograms of hazardous waste and 10,100 kilograms of non-hazardous waste. The company has set waste management goals by 2032, the amount of waste recycling will increase by 10% compared to the base year 2022.


Corporate Governance Structure

A very good to **excellent**average score or **98.25%**



According to the organic farming method based on the circular economy, the project can make use of waste or scrap materials such as food scraps in the office, garbage, grass clippings and left litter in the area, including drinking water that is waste water from the office, to compost or treat. Then, all of these can be used as soil or organic compost and recycled water, all of which enable the project to reduce the cost of circulation and create efficient use of resources.

Organic Rice Framing near FPT depot in Pichit province

BAFS Group by Fuel Pipeline Transportation Limited has promoted and supported farmers in Ban Na Subdistrict, Wachirabarami District, Phichit Province on changing the rice cultivation method from the traditional one that relies on chemical fertilizers to the organic farming method. This project has been supported with knowledge transfer by the Good Soldier Project of the 3rd Army Area. Meanwhile, the Chaipattana Foundation has also introduced and participated in planting rice in farmers' fields. There are 159 rai of farmland in this project.

BAFS Group purchases paddy obtained from the project and process it into rice. Then, it will be packed into 1-kilogram packing bags for distributing to employees, so that employees can consume good quality rice that is cultivated according to the organic farming method and does not rely on chemicals. Rice is also distributed through the organization's social activities. In 2022, rice production was divided into jasmine rice for 16,500 kilograms and Pathum Thani 1 rice for 25,300 kilograms.



Organic Farming Project near FPT fuel depot in Lampang province

BAFS Group by Fuel Pipeline Transportation Limited has promoted and supported farmers in the area of Huai Fang Village, and teachers and students of Sop Prap Pittayakom School at Sop Prap District, Lampang Province, to make use of land for growing vegetables and fruits according to the organic farming methods based on the circular economy. The Good Soldier Project: "Happy Food, Safety Community" of the 3rd Army has provided advice and knowledge. There are 21 rai of farmland in this project.









To create various plants and encourage the community to eat chemical-free vegetables and fruits, plantation plots in the project therefore consist of different types of vegetable gardens, avocado plots, coffee plots, and Nam Dok Mai mango plots, including black oyster mushroom cultivation houses.

ECO-FOREST

Area 54 rai 5,000 trees



BAFS Clean Energy Corporation jointly creates a green space by implementing a forest planting project that imitates natural forest (ECO-Forest). A variety of perennial plants has been grown while a continuing care plan is formulated to ensure the obtaining of complete forest area in the future, which is a good source of carbon storage.


Sustainable Development Goals


