

Notification of Bangkok Aviation Fuel Services Public Company Limited (BAFS) No. 6/2023

Re: Business Continuity Management Policy and Business Continuity Management Objectives

According to the resolution of the Management System Review Meeting of the Executives (Business Continuity Management System) No. 1/2023 on 28th April 2023 to modify the objectives of business continuity management to be consistent with the results of the business impact analysis and the survey of the needs and expectations of stakeholders

To comply with the abovementioned resolution, the Notification of Bangkok Aviation Fuel Services Public Company Limited (BAFS) No. 9/2022 on Business Continuity Management Policy and Business Continuity Management Objectives is hereby repealed, and a new Business Continuity Management Policy and Business Continuity Management Objectives are established as follows:

Business Continuity Management Policy

Bangkok Aviation Fuel Services Public Company Limited (BAFS) operates its core business in providing aviation fuel services according to international standards, focusing on delivering value to stakeholders, the Company's reputation, and image to fulfill the world with sustainable business by delivering value through quality, safety and the environment.

The Executives have therefore established a Business Continuity Management Policy to serve as a guideline for building business continuity management capabilities as well as preventing threats that cause disruptions beyond acceptable levels and enabling the recovery of critical activities within the specified timeframe, in accordance with relevant regulations, rules, requirements, and laws. The policies are as follows:

1. The Company will develop a business continuity management system in accordance with the business continuity management standards to ensure that the Company's business continuity management is effective and continuously improved.
2. BAFS executives and employees are responsible for developing a business continuity management system according to their roles and responsibilities as defined in the business continuity management system.
3. All executives are responsible for driving and supporting various operations according to the business continuity management process, including enhancing and developing the knowledge and capabilities of personnel to ensure effective performance.
4. All executives and employees shall be aware of their contribution to the Company's achievement of its Business Continuity Management Objectives.

To achieve the aforementioned Business Continuity Management Policy, the Company has established the Business Continuity Management Objectives as follows:

Business Continuity Management Objectives

Bangkok Aviation Fuel Services Public Company Limited (BAFS) is committed to conducting its core business of providing aviation fuel services in accordance with international standards, taking into account quality, safety, and the environment, focusing on delivering value to stakeholders throughout the supply chain in a balanced manner covering economic, social, and environmental dimensions to fulfill the world with sustainable business. This includes increasing the Company's capability to respond to and protect the interests of stakeholders, reputation, image, and activities that create value for the Company according to the business continuity management system according to the management system to achieve the following 2 objectives:

1. Preventing threats that cause disruptions beyond the acceptable level by practicing emergency plans no less than 12 times per year per area and practicing Full-scale or BCP plans at least once per year.
2. Recovering key activities to be able to provide aviation refueling services according to the Minimum Acceptable Capacity (MAC) within the specified Recovery Time Objective (RTO) time as follows:

The service at Suvarnabhumi Airport is capable of providing aviation fuel service at 70 percent of Suvarnabhumi Airport's maximum daily service capacity within 2 hours.

The service at Don Mueang Airport is capable of providing aviation fuel service at 60 percent of Don Mueang Airport's maximum daily service capacity within 2 hours.
